

Team Project – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What is required for the 70% Team Project?

For the first team project (worth 70%), your group will be required to **deliver a demo** of your project during **Enrichment Week**. Reflective journal describing how you engaged in simulated work environment involving weekly team.

The *exact date and time* of your demo will be announced soon.

2. Do all team members need to attend the demo?

Yes. **All group members must be present** during the demo in Enrichment Week.

3. What kind of solution can we develop?

Your project solution can be any of the following:

- A **CMS (Content Management System) website**
- A **mobile application**
- A **Game**
- **Any problem addressed such as automation, security, healthcare, etc contributing towards improvement in digital society and quality of life.**
- Or any other appropriate digital solution aligned with your proposed problem

4. What is the individual submission requirement?

Alongside the team demo, each student must submit an **individual reflective journal** document reflecting on the project.

- **Word count:** 2500 words
- **Submission deadline:** 19th May

5. Which brief should we follow?

For CS, IT, AI and Cyber Security programs, please **ignore the CGP student coursework brief**. That brief belongs to a **different cohort** and is **not relevant** to your module.

6. How many members should be in each team?

All teams for both projects must consist **five members**. Team formation will follow this rule for every group.

7. How will the teams be formed for the Industrial Project (30%)?

For the second assessment, each student will choose a project from the provided list.

Based on these project selections, **teams will be formed externally by the teaching team**, not by students.

8. What are the requirements for the Industrial Project?

The Industrial Project assessment includes:

- A **team presentation**

- A **live demo** of your solution
- Submission of your **fully functional product code**.

9. What if we are still struggling to choose a project title?

If you are finding it difficult to decide on a project title, don't stress yourself. Just try to be as simple as you can. Thinking about what your project does should help you decide title for the project.

11. Will there be guest speakers in our classes?

Yes. Throughout the module, we will host a series of exciting guest speakers from industry. These sessions are extremely valuable, as they offer insights into real-world professional practices and provide opportunities to network with industry experts.
